What is the Ruth Institute?

The Ruth Institute is an international interfaith coalition to defend the family and build a Civilization of Love. Founded in 2008 by world-renowned author, speaker and academic Dr. Jennifer Roback Morse, the Ruth Institute equips people to understand, appreciate, and defend traditional Christian sexual ethics by providing scientifically sound evidence, carefully reasoned arguments, and compelling personal testimonies.

What is the Ruth Institute Summit?

Since its inception in 2018, the Annual Awards Dinner and Summit for Survivors of the Sexual Revolution has become one of the signature educational programs of the Ruth Institute. The Summit is built around the idea that the Sexual Revolution has harmed millions of people who are systematically silenced by mainstream culture. Children of Divorce, Post-Abortive Women, Refugees from the Hook-Up Culture or the LGBT and Transgender Subcultures, and many more, are socially invisible. Yet, if their stories were known, many people would change their minds about the desirability of the Sexual Revolution.

The 5th Annual Summit will take place June 24-25, 2022, in Lake Charles, Louisiana.

Who are the Survivors of the Sexual Revolution?

The Sexual Revolution has harmed millions of people. This includes, but is not limited to: children of divorce, divorcees themselves, people who experienced the negative effects of the hook-up culture and one-night stands, those who choose to identify as the opposite sex or parent someone who has, children of unmarried parents, IVF children, women who regret prioritizing their career over family, post-abortive women and men, pornography addicts and their families, and those experiencing health problems from contraception or abortion.

No other event defends the traditional, Christian family by telling the stories of victims and survivors of the Sexual Revolution. Attendees will hear from those who are otherwise socially invisible.
