Dear friends of the Ruth Institute,

The Supreme Court's decision in Dobbs v Jackson Women's Health gave new energy and direction to the pro-life, pro-family movement. And, after two years of dislocation, relocation, and turmoil, the Ruth Institute has found a wonderful solution to our office space problem in Lake Charles.

The Dobbs v Jackson Women's Health case is obviously the news of the year for everyone. Dobbs overturned Roe v. Wade and returned abortion policy-making to the states. Justice Clarence Thomas' concurrence left tantalizing hints about a possible path for overturning so-called "gay marriage" created by the Obergefell case. Political activists on all sides are reevaluating their strategies and redoubling their efforts.

For us at the Ruth Institute, the overturn of Roe was especially poignant. We heard the announcement the morning of our 5th Annual Awards Dinner and Summit for Survivors of the Sexual Revolution. The energy in the room was electric. Those who were there will remember that moment for the rest of our lives. One of our speakers, our dear friend Paul Darrow said, "There's no place I'd rather be to hear this announcement than the Ruth Institute Summit." I wish you could have been there!


**Our Dream:** That all children be welcomed into life in a loving home with their own mother and father, married to each other.



The Sexual Revolution is incompatible with this vision and attempts to separate sex from babies, separate both

from marriage, and wipe out all differences between men and women. These goals are impossible without massive amounts of State power and propaganda.

The Sexual Revolution has harmed millions of people. Up until now, these victims have been socially invisible. We call them "Survivors of the Sexual Revolution." Our strategy is to enlist, educate, and encourage them to become advocates for positive change.







Part of our mission is prayer. The 5th Annual Rosary Around the Lake on October 2nd broke new ground, with decades being recited in French and Spanish. The French language is, of course, a well-known part of Louisiana heritage. And although the Hispanic heritage goes back to before the Louisiana Purchase, many Spanish-speakers are recent immigrants.

State Senator Jeremy Stine led a decade in French, while members of the Hispanic community led a decade in Spanish. Other decades were led in English by members of the Knights of Columbus and several youth and parish groups. As in past years, Bishop Glen John Provost led the Apostles' Creed.

The Ruth Institute started this event in 2018 to pray for the strengthening of families and the Church. We're glad that so many in the local community contributed to making this year's event special.

## "ASK A SURVIVOR" WITH FAITH HAKESLEY



The Ruth Institute was pleased this year to begin a new feature on our website: the "Ask a Survivor" blog featuring Faith Hakesley. Faith is a wife, homeschooling mother, survivor of clergy sex abuse, and author of *Glimmers of Grace*: Moments of Peace and Healing Following Sexual Abuse (Our Sunday Visitor 2020). Having lived through her own traumatic experiences, Faith can easily empathize with others who are suffering. She has become a voice and advocate for survivors.

"Ask a Survivor" is a safe place where anyone can anonymously ask questions regarding victimization, the healing process, and other related topics. The primary goals of the "Ask a Survivor" blog are to bring hope, healing, and awareness to survivors and those who support them. Faith supports readers through empathy and her own lived experience.

Some of the issues Faith has addressed include the grooming process, supporting survivors, re-victimization, marriage after abuse, and reporting abuse to law enforcement. Faith also seeks to motivate readers to practice new coping skills and healthy self-care. She strives to encompass the fullness of the human person by addressing the mind, body, and spirit connection of every human being who has been created in the image and likeness of God.

## DON FEDER, IN-HOUSE EXPERT ON DEMOGRAPHIC WINTER

Ruth Institute Coalitions Director Don Feder spoke on "Demographic Winter: The Fatal Fall of Fertility" March 9 at the VI Annual Ibero-American Congress for Life and Family in Guatemala City, Guatemala.

"Rapidly declining fertility, leading inevitably to population decline, will be the crisis of the century," Feder announced. "Worldwide fertility – the average number of births per woman – has dropped from 4.7 in 1950 to 2.4 in 2017. Sometime in the next ten years, we will probably be below the necessary replacement level of 2.1 children per woman."

"Then population decline will set in. Soon industrialized nations will find it increasingly difficult to find workers to man farms and factories, serve as first responders, teachers and medical personnel, and do the dozens of other jobs necessary to maintain an advanced industrialized civilization."



"Nations like Japan are already losing people. Between 2015 and 2020, Japan's population declined by 800,000. It's projected to fall another 25% by mid-century. So many Japanese are dying alone because they have no children or grandchildren to care for them, that the Japanese have a name for it: 'lonely death.' An industry has even sprung up to dispose of their remains."



More than 200 people participated in the Congress including representatives of some of the largest pro-life and pro-family groups in the United States. The conference was chaired by Guatemalan President Alejandro Giammattei.

# A HISTORIC BEGINNING TO THE FIFTH ANNUAL SUMMIT FOR SURVIVORS OF THE SEXUAL REVOLUTION



"Roe v. Wade has just been overturned."

The Annual Awards Dinner and Summit for Survivors of the Sexual Revolution, June 24-25 in Lake Charles, has become the Ruth Institute's biggest program of the year. This event began in 2018 with an awards dinner and has since expanded into a two-day conference.

By far, the greatest joy of this year's Summit was the news of the Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Supreme Court decision overturning Roe v. Wade. It was my great honor and privilege to share the news after the very first speech of the morning of our Summit. As you can imagine, the people in the room erupted from their seats, clapping, cheering, crying, praying, and singing hymns of praise to God for his great glory.

## THE EMERGING LEADERS PROGRAM



Thanks to a generous grant from a long-time supporter, the Emerging Leaders program provided scholarships for students and young adults to attend the Summit for free. We recruited and selected 28 participants based on their abilities, competence, and commitment to the pro-family cause. This number includes 15 women and 13 men, ranging in age from a 17-year-old high school student who was accompanied by her mother, to a 36-year-old Catholic priest from Uganda. Other attendees included:

- 8 Roman Catholic seminarians from San Francisco, CA; Kansas City, KS; Tyler, TX; and Lake Charles, LA
- 3 political activists: 1 from Puerto Rico, 2 from Texas
- A Catholic high school teacher from San Francisco
- 3 staff members from Pregnancy Care Centers: 1 in Nashville, TN; 1 in Napa, CA; and 1 in Fort Worth, TX
- 3 journalists/freelance writers
- · 2 activists from Students for Life of America
- · A volunteer at a center for autistic children, and
- An aspiring filmmaker

The Emerging Leaders learned from and interacted with our fabulous roster of speakers and awardees. At the same time, these young adults inspired the other participants, most of whom are veterans of pro-life or pro-family activism.




## WINNERS OF THE 2022 ANNUAL AWARDS

### Honoring the unsung heroes of the Sexual Counter-Revolution

### Scholar of the Year

Scott Yenor is a Professor of Political Science at Boise State University, where he teaches political philosophy. He earned his Ph.D. from Loyola University, Chicago (2000) and his B.A. from University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire (1993). He is the author of Family Politics: The Idea of Marriage in Modern Political Thought (2011), David Hume's Humanity: The Philosophy of Common Life and its Limits (2016), The Recovery of Family Life: Exposing the Limits of Modern Ideologies (2020), and multiple articles on David Hume and the Scottish Enlightenment, presidential power, literature and politics, and other topics. He lives in Meridian, Idaho, with his wife, Amy, and his five children.





### Witness of the Year

Walt Heyer lived as a woman for eight years. Thanks to psychotherapy and faith in God, Walt was restored to his male gender. Now, through his website, sexchangeregret.com, he offers hope to others who want to leave the transgender life. He also uses his unique platform to advocate for protecting children from irreversible medical interventions.

Walt has spoken to legislators and at conferences around the world, and his story has been featured in countless articles and documentaries. He has participated in hundreds of radio and TV events, has written seven books and over 60 articles for major publications.

Walt's latest book, Trans Life Survivors, offers up-to-date research and 30 representative stories from the thousands of people who have contacted him for help. His autobiography, A Transgender's Faith, has been the subject of numerous documentaries.

### **Pro-Life Leadership Award**

Kristan Hawkins is a Christian wife, mother, grassroots activist, author, speaker, podcast host, and human rights advocate. President of Students for Life of America and Students for Life Action, she was recruited in 2006 to launch Students for Life of America's full-time operation. Since then, she has built a small organization made up of a few dozen student groups scattered around the country into a coordinated national team that serves 1,200+ Students for Life chapters in all fifty states and has trained over 100,000 young people.

Kristan hosts a weekly podcast, "Explicitly Pro-Life," found on iTunes or YouTube. Under her leadership, Students for Life exists to abolish abortion by transforming our culture through recruiting, training, and mobilizing this pro-life generation, who are the direct targets of today's abortion industry.

### Activist of the Year

Maria Keffler is a co-founder of Advocates Protecting Children, Partners for Ethical Care and the Arlington Parent Coalition (Virginia). She is the author of multiple books, including Desist, Detrans & Detox: Getting Your Child Out of the Gender Cult. 


### Activist of the Year

Erin Brewer, Ph.D., is co-founder of Advocates Protecting Children, which raises awareness of the unethical treatment of children under the duplicitous banner of gender affirmation. She also co-founded the Compassion Coalition, an international group working to ban medical interventions for gender-confused children. She is the author of *Transing Our Children* and *Always Erin*, a children's book about her childhood gender dysphoria. Our Fr. Sullins traveled the world this year, continuing to expose the junk science that supposedly backs up the Sexual Revolution.

The Revolutionaries and their allies in the media continue to try to ignore or discredit Sullins' research on Sexual Orientation Change Efforts (SOCE) and the potential psychological harms of abortion to women. Their pathetic tactics prove they cannot refute his research.

In London, Fr. Sullins participated in a conference entitled, "Where's the Science? How Do Therapy Bans Harm Children and Families?"

His two presentations, "SOCE, Minority Stress and Suicide" and "Child Harm with Same-sex Parents," contributed to a surprising shift in British policymaking. The government suddenly withdrew its proposed ban on "conversion therapy."

Knowledgeable observers credited opposing research, specifically by Fr. Sullins, as a factor in this surprising but welcome development.


In Budapest, Hungary, Fr. Sullins presented "SOCE and Psychological Risk" and workshops on same-sex parents and the natural family at the International Federation for Therapeutic and Counseling Choice.

Fr. Sullins also Zoomed in to another event in Budapest: "Same-sex Parenting and the Well-being of Children" at the "Next Thousand Years for Children" conference.

He also participated remotely at the Behavioral Healthcare Center Conference, Doha, Qatar.

All in all, Fr. Sullins continues to be one of the hidden gems of the Ruth Institute. His research is highly respected and is making a difference around the globe.








### **Facebook Reach**

Every Thursday afternoon, Dr. Morse is on "Driving Home the Faith" on Sacred Heart Radio in Cincinnati, Ohio. She and host Fr. Rob Jack discuss our latest press release on the most recent attack of Christian values by Sexual Revolutionaries. Sadly, they always have plenty to talk about.

Last October, Dr. Morse and Fr. Sullins presented two dozen white roses and a commendation to the Most Reverend Michael Burbidge, Bishop of Arlington, Virginia, as a thank you for helping his people address the gender ideology. In his letter, "A Catechesis on the Human Person and Gender Ideology," Bishop Burbidge told parents not to "buy into that which is false." We thanked Bishop Burbidge for his moral fortitude.





Last November, Dr. Morse was on the Eternal Word Television Network's "Women of Grace." 
