## **OMINOUS SIGN: RUTH INSTITUTE ATTACKED**

In August 2017, CNN published the Southern Poverty Law Center's "Hate Map." *The San Diego Union Tribune* caught wind of a "Hate Group" in San Diego: The Ruth Institute (though we'd actually moved in 2015). Soon after, we issued a press release defending ourselves. We stated:

> "The Ruth Institute's primary focus is family breakdown and its impact on children: understanding it, healing it, ending it. If this makes us a 'hate group,' so be it."

On August 31, Vanco, our credit card processor, shut us down without warning. We believe they were pressured by Wells Fargo Bank due to our new "hate group" status. We were unable to process credit card donations and had to scramble to find a replacement service.



But that setback turned out to be a blessing in disguise. We received tremendous favorable publicity, including a feature with John Stossel. We reached out to all our monthly donors and explained the situation. Most of them increased their contributions! We connected with many new financial supporters and friendly media. We are so grateful for all your support!


#### **RUTH'S STRATEGY: ENLISTING THE SURVIVORS OF THE SEXUAL REVOLUTION**

#### Naming the Problem: The Sexual State

This past August, Dr. Jennifer Roback Morse's latest book, The Sexual State: How Elite Ideologies are Destroying Lives and Why the Church Was Right All Along, was published by TAN Books to great acclaim.

Dr. Morse explains that the Sexual Revolution did not happen spontaneously but was carefully planned and carried out over decades. It consists of three interlocking ideologies:

- The Contraceptive Ideology separating sex from childbearing
- The Divorce Ideology separating sex and childbearing from marriage
- The Gender Ideology eliminating all distinctions between men and women except those that individuals explicitly embrace

- Why is sexual revolutionary propaganda so relentless and increasingly bizarre?
- Do children have a right to be born into an intact family with parents who stay together for life?
- Does contraception prevent abortion or fuel it?
- Are men and women really different and does it matter?
- Is the debate over on "gay marriage"? Is it really a civil rights issue?
- How have sexual revolutionaries used the power of government to re-shape society and eliminate opposition to their agenda?

Reviewers from around the world praised *The Sexual State*. German pro-family heroine and author of *The Global Sexual Revolution*, Gabriele Kuby, stated, "Jennifer Roback Morse pulls back the ideological curtain from the Sexual Revolution. 



### **RUTH INSTITUTE'S 1ST ANNUAL AWARDS DINNER: HONORING OUR HEROES**

On June 15, 2018, the Ruth Institute held its First Annual Awards Dinner in Lake Charles, Louisiana. We were honored that His Excellency, the Most Reverend Bishop Glen John Provost, Roman Catholic Bishop of Lake Charles, attended and gave the invocation.

Awardees included authors, scholars, and activists. Each has made a significant contribution to defending traditional Christian sexual ethics. Dr. Mark Regnerus received the Institute's award for **Scholarship**. Prof. Regnerus teaches sociology at the University of Texas at Austin. He is perhaps best known as the researcher who challenged the belief that the children of same-sex couples do as well as those from heterosexual families.

The Ruth Institute honored Dr. Regnerus for his latest book, Cheap Sex: The Transformation of Men, Marriage, and Monogamy, which describes the brave new world of the Pill, pornography, delayed marriage, and the hookup culture. In presenting the award, Dr. Morse noted that "Mark Regnerus has probably been investigated more than any academic in America. He has been thoroughly vindicated. The University of Texas promoted him to full professor this year. We are pleased to honor him."

Mrs. Caryl Ayala received the Institute's award for Activism and Ruth Institute Book Club Leader of the Year. Mrs. Ayala is one of the co-founders of Concerned Parents of Austin, a grassroots organization made up of educators and parents that equips and informs families of the dangers of Comprehensive Sex Education. She is also the Family Ministry Coordinator at Oak Meadow Baptist Church – a ministry that promotes biblical purity and sexuality.

Mr. Daniel Mattson received the Institute's award for **Public Witness** and was the evening's keynote speaker. Mr. Mattson is a professional musician and author of the book Why I Don't Call Myself Gay. He spoke of his journey from living as a gay man to finding peace, joy, and fulfillment by entering the Catholic Church and living a chaste life.

Also present among the 250 guests was Fr. Paul Sullins, Ph.D., newly hired Research Associate for The Ruth Institute. (See below.)





## **REV. DR. D. PAUL SULLINS**


- is one of the top researchers to challenge the orthodoxy of "no differences" between children of same-sex parents and other children;
- has shown substantially higher rates of problems such as ADHD and depression among children with same-sex parents;
- earned a Ph.D in sociology and taught at Catholic University from 1998 until his recent retirement.
- has written four books and more than 100 journal articles, research reports, and essays on issues of family, faith, and culture;
- was formerly an Episcopalian priest and is now a married Catholic priest;
- produced The Ruth Institute's report on clergy sexual abuse in the Catholic Church.

# **CORE VALUES: SEEK & TELL THE TRUTH**

- The addition of Fr. Paul Sullins, Ph.D., to our staff strengthens The Ruth Institute's reputation for providing high-quality research on marriage, family, and human sexuality. When we originally engaged him in April 2018, we anticipated that he would continue his research on the impact of same-sex parenting on children. We highlight some of his results below.
- As the summer unfolded, however, his skills as a sociologist were put to work analyzing the relationship between homosexuality in the Catholic priesthood and clergy sexual abuse. This report, released in November, showed a strong correlation between the numbers of priests describing themselves as homosexual and the incidence of sexual abuse of minors.
- We cannot fully gauge the impact of the Clergy Sexual Abuse Report as this Annual Report goes to press. However, it has already been downloaded more than 4,000 times from our website and is making a significant impact on the discussion of the problems of clergy sexual misconduct in the Catholic Church. San Francisco Archbishop Salvatore Cordileone referred to the report during the annual meeting of the U.S. Conference of Bishops. Spanish, Italian, and German media outlets have reported on the study. Stay tuned for further developments.


## The Key Questions

- Will the claim that there are no differences between the children of same-sex parents and married heterosexual parents stand up under more intense examination with better data?
- What are some of the elevated risks that children of same-sex parents face?
- How can we convey this information to the public?



# Integral to Ruth's mission to defend the family at home & in the public square

- Treating same-sex couples as the legal equivalent of opposite-sex couples means increasing numbers of children will be raised in same-sex couple households.
- More information will be coming available about the experiences of children in same-sex households.
- We owe it to these children and their families to examine this evidence in a systematic way.



• These families embarked in same-sex parenting with the ideologically-driven assurance of the "experts" that the kids would be fine. Accurate information about risk factors will help these families, as well as aid in debating future policy issues.

# **CORE VALUES: KEEP OUR EYES ON JESUS CHRIST** Rosary Around the Lake: A Local Event with National Implications

Though national, and indeed international in scope, The Ruth Institute hasn't forgotten the adage: All politics is local. While we conduct programs nationwide, like those offering recovery for the survivors of divorce, we're also creating an activist base with a network in our own backyard.

As part of this, the Institute was the local sponsor of Rosary Coast to Coast, which took place on October 7 with a Rosary Around the Lake.



The more than 800 participants included young and old -- Catholics and non-Catholics who see the benefit of prayer -- from all walks of life. We prayed for Divine Protection, Pardon from Sin, Salvation of Souls, and the Reunion of All Christians.



Rosary Around the Lake was part of a series of Ruth Institute events that included our first annual banquet this past June and will continue with a conference next spring covering a range of issues relating to the family and traditional morality.

We now have a larger volunteer base in our hometown that can participate in training people of faith to speak out for the family and traditional morality everywhere. They are an army mobilizing for spiritual warfare across the United States.
